AACRL is seeking nominations for the positions of Vice-President / President-Elect and Treasurer. The term as Vice-President / President-Elect covers three years, one year as Vice-President, one year as President, and one year as Past-President. Duties of the Vice President/President-Elect are as follows:

The Vice-President / President-Elect shall serve as a chapter representative and attend the ACRL Chapters Council; in consultation with the President, prepare and report to the Executive Board of the local chapter proposed budgets of the upcoming year (the term as President); serve as Chair of the Program Committee; serve as Chair of the Continuing Education and Training Committee; preside, in the absence of the President, at all meetings of the chapter; and perform other duties as assigned by the President.

The term as Treasurer is two years and the duties include reporting to the chapter membership, at least annually, on the financial status of the chapter; maintaining necessary accounts with an accounting of all chapter monies; maintaining an active membership list; sending membership applications and renewals to the Member-at-Large; submitting end-of-year reimbursement reports to ACRL in accordance with its guidelines; filing necessary non-profit organization tax forms with the IRS; and performing other duties as assigned by the President.

Project Accessible Libraries for All (ALFA)

Applications are now being accepted for Fall 2011 admission to The University of Alabama School of Library and Information Studies for eight full, competitive scholarships available for students interested in focusing their studies in the area of universal access.

The Project ALFA (Accessible Libraries for All) scholarships are made available through an IMLS grant awarded to Assistant Professor, Dr. Laurie Bonnici, to prepare students for working with clients facing physical access barriers. Universal access extends considerations of physical access beyond the ADA definition to include aging populations and persons with mild to moderate or temporary physical disabilities.

In addition to full tuition, ALFA Scholars will receive a laptop computer to support their studies as well as limited funds to travel to grant-related meetings and conferences.
